until their economies are much stronger. Globally, the science suggests that climate change will likely wreak havoc on food production in the developing world, but that it's the poor who will suffer the most. Yet many of the world's largest economies, particularly the U.S., are reluctant to give up the bulk of their fossil fuel reserves until such time as they can be confident of their ability to maintain economic growth and support their citizens. A new study out of Stanford University published in the journal Nature Climate Change confirms that the poorest countries are the least likely to be able to implement effective climate change policies. "Poor people have a lot to lose from climate change, so it's important to reduce that vulnerability," said Joseph Aldy, an associate professor of law at Stanford

and one of the study's authors. "But the wealthier countries also have a lot to lose." The study took a look at the projected effects of climate change on developing countries, comparing the countries' economic and technical capabilities to their potential for adapting to the changes already underway. In the end, it found that the developing countries are better positioned to deal with climate change than the industrialized countries. While these countries have the most at stake, they also have the most to gain from cutting greenhouse gas emissions. "If you're a country like Bangladesh, there are all kinds of reasons you're concerned about climate change," Aldy told The Daily Caller News Foundation. "But you also have the good sense to know that unless your economy is
